Call for Abstracts

Abstracts covering the various areas of basic and clinically applied platelet research are welcome.

Abstracts will be presented as oral communications (10 to 15 minutes) or posters (Required poster size is A0 format (1189 (height) × 841 mm (width)).

The authors are asked to indicate whether they prefer oral communication or poster presentation. However, final decision about the type of presentation will be made by the organizers.

Deadline for abstract submission: May 1th 2006

Authors will be informed about the acceptance of their abstract(s) before May 15th 2006. Abstracts should be submitted as text files (preferentially MS Word) by e-mail to: platelet@p.lodz.pl

The abstracts should not exceed 400 words and should have the following formatting:

- Font: Arial 11 pt
- Line space: single
- Title: capitals, bold, followed by a blank line
- Family name(s) of the author(s) preceded by initial (s) of the first name(s): italic, bold, followed by a blank line
- Institution, city, country: italic, followed by a blank line
- The name of the presenting author should be underlined
- The text of the abstract should be divided in the following sections: Background, Methods, Results and Conclusion.

Each section should be a single paragraph. There should be no space between the paragraphs.
